

1. A duly advertised regular meeting of the Board of Education was called to order by President Buddy Bosler at 7:30 p.m. in the North Harrison Middle School Cafeteria.
2. Secretary Robert Chinn polled the Board and found that all members were present.
3. Mr. Ron Coleman moved and Mr. Gary Byrne seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the February 12, 2007 regular meeting and the minutes of the February 15, 2007, February 19, 2007, February 22, 2007 and March 1, 2007 executive session meetings. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
4. Mr. Buddy Bosler asked if the state has approved the transportation budget.
5. Superintendent Monty Schneider stated the state has yet to approve the transportation budget.
6. Mr. Gary Byrne asked how much money had the school corporation used from the capital project fund to get the North Harrison Elementary renovation project started.
7. Superintendent Monty Schneider estimated \$600,000 - \$700,000 has been used from the capital project fund to start the North Harrison Elementary project.
8. Mr. Robert Chinn asked the status of the Rainy Day Fund.
9. Superintendent Monty Schneider explained the Rainy Day Fund.
10. Mr. Gary Byrne asked the Middle School shop motors.
11. Maintenance Supervisor Jeff Brown explained the replacement of the Middle School motors.
12. Mr. Robert Chinn moved and Mr. Fred Naegele seconded a motion to approve merchant claims #218 through #393 and the payrolls for March 16 and 30, 2007. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
13. Superintendent Monty Schneider introduced the North Harrison Community School Building Corporation for the North Harrison Elementary renovation project. The members include Mr. Jerry Atkins (President), Mr. Dan Wolfe (Vice-President), Mr. Brian Churchill (Treasurer), Mr. Norman Swarens – absent (Secretary) and Mr. Scott Trowbridge (Assistant Secretary).
14. Superintendent Monty Schneider explained the school bond process.
15. School Corporation Attorney David Layson explained the duties of the Building Corporation.
16. Mr. Brian Churchill moved and Mr. Dan Wolfe seconded a motion to have the Building Corporation purchase North Harrison Elementary School and adjoining land from the school corporation for \$300,000.00. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
17. Mr. Scott Trowbridge moved and Mr. Brian Churchill seconded a motion to appoint Assistant Superintendent Ken Opiel as the lessor's representative. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
18. Mr. Dan Wolfe moved and Mr. Scott Trowbridge seconded a motion to authorize the president and secretary to sign papers on behalf of the building corporation. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
19. Mr. Brian Churchill moved and Mr. Dan Wolfe seconded a motion to adjourn the Building Corporation meeting. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
20. Mr. David Layson explained the process of selling the North Harrison Elementary to the Building Corporation and continual disclosure.
21. Mr. Fred Naegele moved and Mr. Robert Chinn seconded a motion to approve the sale of North Harrison Elementary School and adjoining land to the Building Corporation, continual disclosure, the president and secretary to sign papers on behalf of the school corporation, and to assign the construction contracts to the Building Corporation. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

22. Mr. Gordon Ingle and North Harrison High School Assistant Principal Doug Dodge updated the Board on the Harrison County Alternative School.
23. NHHS Assistant Principal Doug Dodge updated the Board on a national conference in San Diego that the Alternative School board attended.
24. Mr. Buddy Bosler thanked the Alternative School board for their work.
25. Mr. Gordon Ingle asked the Board to appoint someone to the Alternative School board.
26. Mr. Buddy Bosler stated that the Board will appoint someone to the Alternative School board during the April Board meeting.
27. Mr. Robert Chinn moved and Mr. Ron Coleman seconded a motion to approve the resignations of Mrs. Rebeka Gilley as an instructional assistant at Morgan Elementary School effective March 2, 2007; Mrs. Joanna Allen as a library assistant at North Harrison Middle School effective March 9, 2007; Mr. Ethan Maple as boy's head soccer coach (lay) at North Harrison High School effective February 28, 2007; Mrs. Sara Sizemore and Mrs. Lisa Hitner as 7th and 8th grade co-cheer coaches (lay) at North Harrison Middle School effective March 10, 2007; Mrs. Sandra Schmidt and Mrs. Jill Murphy as co-sixth grade cheer coaches (lay) at North Harrison Middle School effective March 10, 2007; Mr. Blake Snodgrass as eighth grade boy's basketball coach (lay) at North Harrison Middle School; and Mr. Kreig Reed as seventh grade boy's basketball coach (lay) at North Harrison Middle School. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
28. Mr. Buddy Bosler asked if three (3) technology technicians are necessary.
29. Technology Director Harve Trowbridge explained that he believes to maintain service, that three (3) technology technicians are necessary.
30. Mr. Fred Naegele moved and Mr. Gary Byrne seconded a motion to approve the appointments of Mrs. Michelle (Shelly) Robertson as girl's track coach (lay) at North Harrison Middle School; Miss Jessica Oehmann as an elementary teacher (temporary contract) from January 16, 2007 until an undetermined date in the spring when Mrs. Kathy Bezy returns from medical leave; Mrs. Kathy Kaiser as a part time cafeteria worker at Morgan Elementary School; Mrs. Dee McAfee as 7th and 8th grade cheer coach (lay) at North Harrison Middle School; and Miss Beth Burson as a Technology Integration Specialist for the corporation. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
31. Mr. Robert Chinn moved and Mr. Ron Coleman seconded a motion to grant Mrs. Tonya Webb an unpaid leave of absence for the 2007-2008 school year. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
32. Mr. Robert Chinn moved and Mr. Ron Coleman seconded a motion to approve GreenLeaf Landscaping and Nursery's bid of \$130.00 per mowing for lawn care at Morgan Elementary School for the 2007 mowing season. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
33. The Board directed Assistant Superintendent Ken Oppel to request lawn mowing bids for the North Harrison campus.
34. Mr. Ron Coleman moved and Mr. Robert Chinn seconded a motion to approve the following Board Policies: Food Allergy; Withdrawal from School Exit Interview and form; Reporting a Threat or Intimidation Against a School Employee; Disclosure of Student Lists and form; Certificate of Incapacity and form. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
35. Mr. Gary Byrne moved and Mr. Fred Naegele seconded a motion to authorize the administration to advertise for bids such as fuel, bread, milk and commodities. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
36. Mr. Robert Chinn moved and Mr. Gary Byrne seconded a motion to approve a \$550 donation from the Knights of Columbus for Special Needs class at North Harrison High School (no match); \$3,825.00 from the Harrison County Community Foundation for Camp Kindergarten at both elementary schools (no match); \$25,000 from the Harrison County Community Foundation for bus security cameras for the corporation (match required); \$12,500.00 from the Harrison County Community Foundation for storage boxes on school buses (match required); \$2,553.00 from the Harrison County Community Foundation for AlphaSmart NEO's at the Middle School (match required); \$2,261.00 from the Harrison County Community Foundation for materials to build tables at the High School greenhouse (match required); \$2,750.00 from the Harrison County Community Foundation for security cameras at the High School (match required); and \$4,000.00 from the Harrison County

Community Foundation for painting band trailers at the High School (match required). The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

37. Assistant Superintendent Ken Oppel explained that on April 18 (weather permitting) the North Harrison Community Schools will participate in a campus wide evacuation drill.
38. Mrs. Susan Isbell thanked Superintendent Monty Schneider for his service.
39. Vice-President Ron Zink of the North Harrison Classroom Teachers Association thanked Superintendent Monty Schneider for his service, questioned if the Middle School library hours will remain the same, updated the Board on contract negotiations.
40. North Harrison High School Principal Kelly Simpson updated the Board on athletics, winter and drum guard contests, the high school musical, GQE and thanked Mrs. Donnetta Reed for her work on the Red Cross Blood Drive.
41. North Harrison Middle School Principal Jon Howerton updated the Board on athletics, band and choir contests, Prosser visit and 6th grade Destination Imagination.
42. North Harrison Elementary School Principal Lisa Jones thanked the HCCF for funding Camp Kindergarten and updated the Board on Read Across America, science fair, parent-teacher conferences, PTO family night and finally stated that Miss Beth Burson will be a great addition to the technology staff.
43. Morgan Elementary School Principal Lance Richards thanked the HCCF for funding Camp Kindergarten, updated the Board on Buddy Readers, parent teacher conferences, Dodge Ball for WHAS Crusade for Children and he thanked the Palmyra Volunteer Fire Department for participating.
44. Maintenance Supervisor Jeff Brown updated the Board on the work scheduled for spring break.
45. North Harrison High School Assistant Principal Doug Dodge thanked the HCCF for funding so many projects.
46. Technology Director Harve Trowbridge thanked the Board for hiring Beth Burson as the new Technology Integration Specialist and he updated the Board on riverboat spending plan.
47. Mr. Greg Rupp, President of the North Harrison Classroom Teachers Association, stated that he believed that negotiations are going well concerning the teachers contract.
48. Mr. Gary Byrne thanked the HCCF and staff for writing the HCCF grants. He also stated that he hopes the teacher contract gets settled.
49. Mr. Fred Naegele thanked the Building Corporation for the North Harrison Elementary Renovation project, the Alternative School Board and Mr. Brian Churchill for their service.
50. Mr. Robert Chinn, Mr. Ron Coleman and Mr. Buddy Bosler each thanked the HCCF and staff for writing the HCCF grants, the Alternative School Board and the Building Corporation for the North Harrison Elementary Renovation project.
51. Mr. Ron Coleman moved and Mr. Gary Byrne seconded a motion to adjourn the Board meeting. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
52. The meeting adjourned at 9:27 p.m.
53. At 9:37 p.m., the Board met in executive session with members all members present. Also present were Monty Schneider, Ken Oppel, Kelly Simpson, Doug Dodge, Jon Howerton, Lance Richards and Lisa Jones. The executive session ended at 9:57 p.m. with no action being taken.
